There are four WinLink Servers (RMS units) in Lee and Charlotte County...

Note: There is a unit planned for Cape Coral on 432.700, but it is not yet operational

Charlotte County has a WinLink Digipeater for those who cannot reach their County EOC RMS directly. It also operates on 433.000 MHz and its' call is: W4DIG-8. *Note:* It only handles 1200 Baud Packet messages.

To use the Charlotte County Digipeater, in your "Connection Dialog" you would check: Connection Type "Digipeater" then enter W4DIG-10 in the next box, followed by W4DIG-8 in the "VIA" box. (This assume you are planning to send your message through the W4DIG-10 RMS unit.)

Reminder: WinLink Digipeaters, like APRS Digipeaters must operate on the same frequency as the "next unit in line." Which is why both the Charlotte EOC RMS and the Digipeater both operate on 433.000 MHz.

Note: There are no Digipeaters in operation in Lee County. We chose to set up a group of RMS units instead. That way, if one goes down or loses its' Internet Connection, the others should still be available to users.
